



## SAS Warranty

WARRANTY means failure to comply with, or failure to operate due to the unit having defects in workmanship or material. Normal wear and tear and the need for regular overhaul and periodic maintenance do not constitute a warranty event. The warranty period for repaired, serviceable, or tested Products is 3 months after installation of Products or 6 months after shipment if not installed and will be free from defects in workmanship and material. The warranty is limited to the repaired portion of the Product. The warranty period for overhauled Products is 6 months after the installation of Products or 1 year after shipment if not installed and applies to the entire Product. Repairs that are performed as part of either an original new product warranty or a repair or overhaul warranty will not extend either the original new product warranty period or the repair or overhaul warranty period, as applicable. These warranties run to the Buyer, its successors, assigns, and customers. Buyer must notify Superior Aviation in writing during the warranty period and, within 30 calendar days of discovery of the warranty. Superior Aviation obligation and Buyer's sole remedy under this warranty is repair or replacement, at Superior Aviation's election. All Products repaired or replaced are warranted only for the unexpired portion of the original warranty period. Superior Aviation will not be liable under this warranty if the Product has been exposed or subjected to any:

- a) maintenance, repair, installation, handling, packaging, transportation, storage, operation or use which is improper or otherwise not in compliance with Superior Aviation's instruction;
- b) alteration, modification or repair by anyone other than the OEM or those specifically authorized by an OEM;
- c) accident, contamination, FOD, Abuse, neglect or negligence after shipment to Buyer;
- d) damage caused by failure of a Superior Aviation supplied Product not under warranty or by any hardware or software not supplied by the OEM of the supplied product;
- e) use of counterfeit or replacement parts that are neither manufactured nor approved by OEM for use in the OEM manufactured Products;
- f) Products which are normally consumed in operation or which have a normal life inherently shorter than the foregoing warranty period including, but not limited to, consumables (e.g. flash tubes, lamps, batteries, storage capacitors, filters, membranes).

Superior Aviation has no obligation under this warranty unless Buyer maintains records that accurately document operating time, maintenance performed and the nature of the unsatisfactory condition of Superior Aviation provided Product. The buyer will give Superior Aviation access to these records for substantiating warranty claims.
